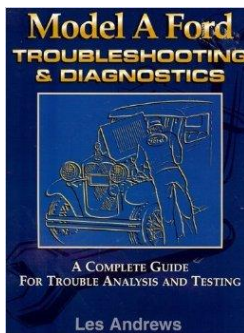

## Highlights from the Annual Business Meeting

The Southside A's 2013 Annual Business was held on November 2, 2013 at the Nikko Japanese Steak House in Tyrone, GA.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Co-Director Tom Miller.

- **Proposed changes to the club's Bylaws -**

Tom gave an overview of the proposed changes to the Bylaws. The two major changes were the Southside A's affiliating with the Model a Ford Club of America (MAFCA), and changes to the structure of the Board of Directors.

Tom opened the floor for comments and/or discussion on the affiliation with MAFCA. It was made clear that the Southside A's primary affiliation would continue be with the Model A Restorer's Club (MARC). It was also clarified that members of the Southside A's would not have to join MAFCA unless they choose to serve on the SSA's Board of directors as MAFCA requires the clubs officers to be members of MAFCA.

The Board of Directors will be reduced to (7) voting members. The current structure allowed an unlimited number of voting members as each chairperson was a voting member. Also the Corresponding Secretary and Secretary positions will be combined into one position.

Following the discussion a vote was taken by show of hands, and 2/3 majority was achieved to pass the changes to the Bylaws.

- **Election of Officers for 2014**

Prior to the election Tom recognized and thanked the 2013 Board and Committee Chairs.

Tom then introduced Dick Carne, Chairman of the Nominating Committee. Dick presented the Nominating Committees recommended slate of officers as follows -

President/Director - Larry Peterson

Vice President/Director - Bob Simpson

Treasurer - Betty Miller

Secretary/Corresponding Secretary - Jim Johnston

Tom then asked for nominations from the floor for each office. No other nominations were presented and a vote was held by show of hands and the slate presented by the Nominating Committee was elected.

- **MAFFI**

Gwyneth Shotwell explained a new MAFFI membership drive focused on the regional clubs. If (3) members of the SSA's join MAFFI they will in turn give the SSA's a free brick to be displayed at the museum. The normal cost for a brick is \$150.00. Mike & Gwyneth Shotwell have MAFFI applications for those interested.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:10 PM.

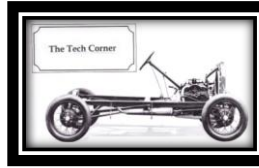

## The Tech Corner

This is a reprint from the Dec., 1960 issue of MARC News (later the Model A News)

I was recently given a copy of "The National Used Car Market Report-Red Book" for October, November, December 1932. This is the book the car salesmen carried to estimate the trade in value of your car on a trade-in. It is an auxiliary to the "infamous" Blue Book which every car buyer figures is out to "take him to the cleaners". At any rate, the first section I turned to was, of course, the '28-31 Ford. It enough to make an "A" fan beat his head against the wall. If "they" only knew! Here are some quotations:

This was in the depths of the depression. 1927 T runabouts were averaged at six bucks apiece. Anything earlier than '27 were usually marked "Salvage". The open cars took an awful beating trade-in time, but the closed held up pretty well; e.g. '30-31 Tudors sold for \$495 and \$490 respectively and were valued at \$115 and \$175. I listed only the "collectors items"...there should be a third column to show what they are valued at today, as is!

The '32 4's and 8's had the same proportion of depreciation. Example:

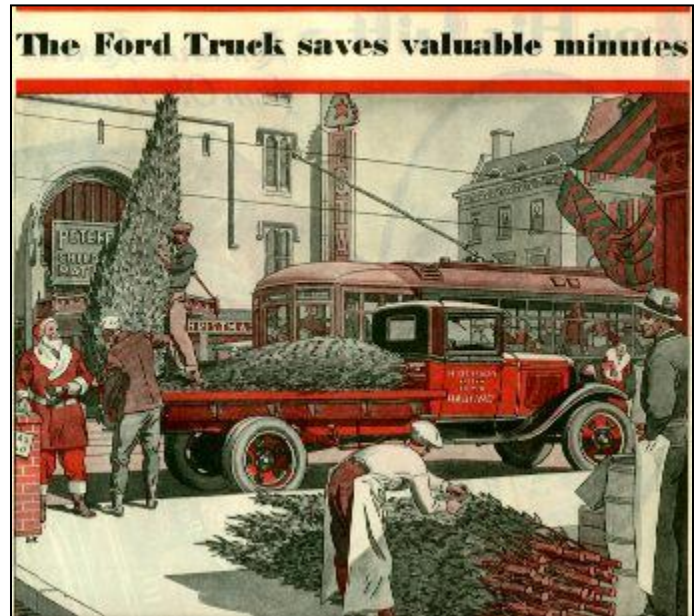

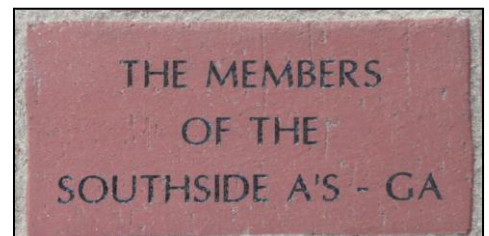

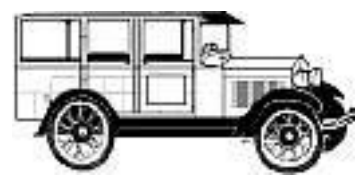

## 1964 Corvair Monza Convertible

I know it is not a Model A but you may know someone who could be interested in the car. Last driven in 1978 when placed in storage. Since waking it up we have a rebuilt engine installed along with new clutch, 4 speed transmission, differential, starter, complete brake system, battery, radial tires, etc. Stripped to rare metal and repainted the original medium blue.
