



If your Model A is registered in the program, please read your odometer and contact **PAT TYLER** at 706-594-4610 or pat@patpamtyler.com Pat must gather the reading and make our report to the National Driving Awards Chairman, so please get your odometer reading to him as soon as possible. If your Model A is not registered for this program, consider signing up. MARC

Once your car is registered, we will report your odometer reading annually and once your car has reported 2,000 miles, you will receive a 2,000 mile award. The second award comes at 5,000 miles, and then at each 5,000 mile interval. Miles driven are cumulative. There is a \$1.00, one-time registration fee. You need to have an operating odometer. 




EUFAULA CHRISTMAS TOUR OF HOMES DECEMBER 2, 2017


The Christmas tour of homes in Eufaula, Alabama, took place on Saturday, December 2, with members of the Southside A's being joined by others from the Gold Mine Region.



You can purchase this book, Part 1, for just \$25.00 by check or money order (USA only).



MAFCA Tiny Tip from September, 2017

TINY TIPS

MODEL A CAPACITIES - 600W OIL

Having just completed rebuilding the running gear portion of my current Model A project, I needed to procure 600W oil for the differential, transmission, and steering box. So off I went to hit the books to determine just how much I should buy. Much to my consternation, I found a number of opinions as to how much 600W I needed for the differential. The following sources offered a variety of information:

- Ford Service Bulletins, page 227 = 1 1/2 pts.
- Model A Ford Service Bulletins. page 375 = 1 1/2 qts. (obviously a typo).
- Model A Miseries & Cures. page 99 = 1 1/2 pts.
- How To Restore Your Model A, Vol 5, page 10 = 2 1/4 pts.
- Model A Mechanics Handbook, page iv = 2 1/4 pts.
- How To Restore Your Model A, Vol 2, page 17 = "up to and not above filler hole."

Undaunted by the diversity of opinions. I decided the last one listed above was the best course of action. It also agreed with my

recollection of what we did when I was employed at a gas station 50 years ago.

My finding, when I filled the complete empty differential, shown in the accompanying photo, was that it took exactly one quart bottle or 2 pts. of 600W oil to reach the level of the filler hole.
